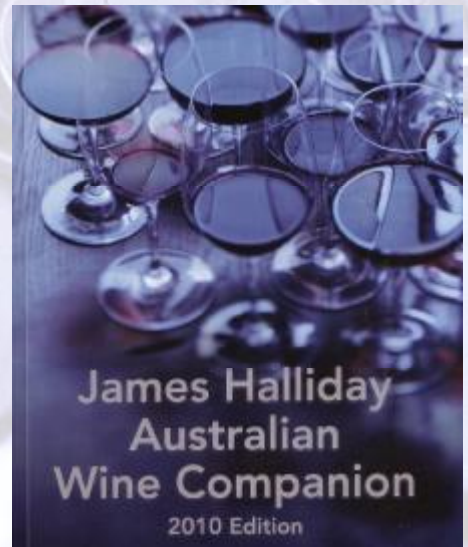


James Halliday 2010 Wine Companion: Pertaringa 2007 **Undercover Shiraz** triumphs with 5 stars and 95 points!

Undercover Shiraz 2007

Bright colour; a dark and dense, almost mysterious array of aromas, with mulled blackberry and slightly tarry elements coming to the fore; the palate is lively and has a vibrant, essency core of fruit, handling the quite firm structure with ease; long, savoury and well put together.

Rifle & Hunt Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

Waves of blackcurrant and dark chocolate come through on the bouquet, gaining further strength on the full-bodied palate; will be a very long-lived wine.
ProCork. 14.5 % alc. Rating 93 To 2022 \$35



Over the Top Shiraz 2007

Medium- to full-bodied, and strongly regional, black fruits interwoven with dark chocolate and a twist of licorice; has good length and carries the alcohol well.
ProCork. 15% alc. Rating 90 To 2020 \$39



Scarecrow Sauvignon Blanc 2008

Minerally grass and capsicum characters are the drivers of the palate, which has freshness and length.
Screwcap. 12.5% alc. Rating 90 To 2010 \$18



Bonfire Block Semillon 2008

A 'brief interlude' in new French oak has made as much impact on texture as flavour; a concentrated wine with good balance and length.
Screwcap. 13.5% alc. Rating 90 To 2014 \$18



Understudy Cabernet Petit Verdot 2007

Strong crimson-purple; a quite firm, but still medium-bodied, palate features fresh blackcurrant and blackberry fruit supported by balanced tannins.
Screwcap. 15% alc. Rating 90 To 2017 \$20



Stage Left Merlot 2007

A robust wine, with rich and velvety cassis / blackcurrant fruit supported by appropriate tannins and oak. Will repay cellaring. Screwcap. 14.5% alc. Rating 90 To 2013 \$20
